INDIANAPOLIS: Twenty-seven high school students and alumni received a prestigious AP Scholar award from the national College Board. Awards are based on exemplary college-level achievement through Advanced Placement (AP) courses and exams. The students attend Herron High School, recently recognized by the Indiana Department of Education for the school's outstanding efforts to engage students in academic rigor through college level coursework. Herron High School currently offers 14 Advanced Placement courses. The AP program is open to all students.
